Work Schedule:

40 hours a week (schedule varied/flexible); 1-2 trips over the course of the summer

Job Summary:

This position allows an individual, on a full-time basis, the opportunity to discover and explore their passion for youth ministry. In doing so, the individual adds perspective, shares in responsibilities within the ministry of the youth department and allows for more one-on-one connections with students throughout the summer.

The overarching responsibilities of the summer interns are to create connections with youth while also providing support and creativity to the full-time staff during the summer months. The intern will create and execute multiple youth events each week, as well as staff meetings and planning time (determined in collaboration with the youth staff). Although weekly program/office hours are flexible, it is also recommended that the interns plan time for connecting with students outside of program/office hours. Finally, summer interns also attend 1-2 trips over the summer and are responsible for helping plan and create different elements of the trip in partnership with the youth ministry staff.

Responsibilities:

- Help create, execute and attend weekly summer programs (determined in discussion with the Youth Ministry staff).
- Attend the weekly department meeting and collaborate as part of a professional team.
- Help plan and organize youth trips, attend/travel on 1-2 summer youth trips, and share the responsibility of helping the trip run smoothly.
- Reach out to students on a weekly basis and connect with them outside of regular weekly programming.
- Develop own faith life through involvement in the church, specifically attending worship on a regular basis during the summer.
